

Global Distributists Membership Recruitment Strategy (Draft)

1. Establish a clear and compelling party message:
 - (a) Develop a succinct summary of the party's core values, goals, and policies that will resonate with potential members.
 - (b) Create and distribute promotional materials (such as brochures, flyers, and posters) that highlight the party's message.

Utilize social media and digital platforms:

- (a) Create and maintain an engaging and informative presence on popular social media platforms (e.g., Facebook, Twitter, Instagram).
